Application and Decision Dates for admission to Junior Infants for 2025/2026

The following are the dates applicable for admission to **Junior Infants**

1. The school will commence accepting applications for admission on:	1st October 2024
2. The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on:	22nd November 2024
3. The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is:	13th December 2024
4. The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is:	7 days

Note: Applications made after the 22nd November 2024 will be processed as late applications. The school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Failure of an applicant to accept an offer within 7 days of the offer being made may result in the offer being withdrawn.

4. The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is:	7 days
